These young people fulfill service learning requirements, learn about science, make friends and meet professionals in science careers while sharing information about exhibits with museum visitors and the community. This program bridges the worlds of school and work; participants in the Science Minors program will develop their job skills, knowledge of science and science careers through their involvement with Museum staff and other resources. Young people who are at least 16 years of age and successfully complete 50 hours of service are eligible to apply for a paid summer position at the Museum.
