WHAT: Media are invited to the kick off National Robotics Week celebrations at the

Museum of Science and Industry, Chicago. On April 8, 9, 14 and 15, guests can participate in various robotics activities, including drone racing and interacting with 'bots built by middle school, high school and college students. **Media are welcome to cover the first day of events on Saturday, April 8** from 9 – 11 a.m. An MSI spokesperson as well as student robotic teams will

be available for interviews.

During these select dates, guests will have opportunities to watch professionals race drones along an indoor racetrack; engage with student robotics teams who will showcase their own robot creations; interact with robots, including a therapeutic baby seal named PARO; and build a robot antenna, discover their robot name, and more.
