MSI TOP FIELD TRIP DESTINATION FOR SCHOOL GROUPS IN 2010

CHICAGO (Jan. 26, 2011) — For the second year in a row, the Museum of Science and Industry, Chicago led area museums and zoos in hosting the most school groups, with over 322,800 students visiting in 2010.

MSI's school group attendance grew 21 percent over the previous year, when more than 266,000 students visited.

One of the largest science museums in the world, the Museum is home to more than 35,000 artifacts and nearly 14 acres of hands-on exhibits designed to spark scientific inquiry and creativity.

"We're pleased that so many schoolchildren are able to explore science with us," said David Mosen, Museum president and CEO. "It's our hope that their visit will help inspire and motivate them to one day consider careers in science, technology, medicine or engineering."

Over 20,000 students in 2010 dove deeper into science during their field trip by participating in educational Learning Labs. Led by Museum educators, students experimented in 15 different programs on forensic science, environmental science, medical technology and more.

MSI also worked with 1,000 teachers in 2010 in science teacher education courses offered through its Center for the Advancement of Science Education. Courses increase teachers' knowledge of science, improve their teaching skills and demonstrate how to use Museum programs and exhibits to enhance science curriculum. Teachers can take MSI courses for a master of science education degree offered in partnership with Illinois Institute of Technology.

MSI offers free general admission to Illinois school groups. Illinois teachers also receive free admission every day, just by showing their educator ID card.
