

Science Leadership School Partners Program: Time Requirements for Returning School Partners (Year 2)

This table outlines the minimum recommended time necessary to support all program components. Innovation and change in science education happen over time. Schools who can allot more time to the process will see a higher rate of change.

In Year 2, School Partners continue to use MSI's School Support Tool as a team to build shared understanding, gauge their school's current science program, and develop an action and implementation plan that prioritizes science at the whole-school level. For Year 2, teams advance the school's science program with greater depth through more long-term action planning and implementation, continuing the work from Year 1.

<u>Additional Time Requirement:</u> All cross-disciplinary school team members, including the School Partner Teacher Leader and administrator, will need a minimum of 2-3 hours (total) to prepare for or follow up on all team meetings.

^{*}Cross-disciplinary team meeting times are dependent on how time is managed at the school site. Assuming all meetings start on time, everyone is present, and the meeting time and process are facilitated efficiently, the approximated 8.5 hours can be achieved.
