<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A structured, democratic process for whole-school change around science education • A three-year partnership opportunity where MSI trains the School Partner Teacher Leader; supports the administrator; and serves as a consultant, coach, and observer of best practices to implement school-wide change over time • A differentiated process that meets the needs of individual schools wherever they are in science/STEM • A cross-disciplinary team that includes an administrator and members from across grade levels and disciplines in a school, and is facilitated by a Teacher Leader • Grounded in current education research to help participants gauge science education across their school • A process that includes evidence gathering, rating, and action planning and implementation • A way for cross-disciplinary teams to engage in honest, reflective discussions that identify what is needed to prioritize science 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Curriculum for K-8 science or STEM education • STEM or NGSS professional development • A rubric or a checklist used by one or a number of science teachers • A “one size fits all” solution • A judgment or score of the school’s deficiencies in science programming • Short-term change • A process led by MSI at MSI • A process led by the administrator at the school
