2019 BLACK CREATIVITY PROGRAMMING KICKS OFF WITH OPENING OF LONGEST-RUNNING EXHIBITION OF AFRICAN-AMERICAN ART IN THE NATION

Annual program includes Juried Art Exhibition featuring more than 170 artworks, hands-on Innovation Studio honoring legacy of African-American innovators, and more

CHICAGO, **III.** (January 14, 2019)—The 2019 Black Creativity program, an annual staple at the Museum of Science and Industry, Chicago (MSI), since 1970, begins January 14 with the *Juried Art Exhibition*, the longest-running gallery of African-American art. The exhibition, the largest in the program's history, features more than 170 works of art from professional and student artists, with past alumni including Chicago's Harmonia Rosales and Hebru Brantley.

The *Juried Art Exhibition* kick off a series of experiences and events throughout January and February that celebrate the achievements of African-American creators and innovators. Guests can explore these rich contributions through hands-on experiences that are included with Museum Entry, and free for Illinois residents most of January and February through the Museum's Illinois resident free days.

Juried Art Exhibition January 14 - February 24

This year this gallery is the largest in Black Creativity history, featuring more than 170 dynamic works from African-American professional and student artists that were chosen by a panel of five jurors. From the exhibition, the panel selects first, second and third place overall show winners, as well as a winner in each medium category and overall in the youth category. *Included with Museum Entry.*

Family Day + Innovation Studio January 21 – February 24

On Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, guests are invited to celebrate during MSI's annual Black Creativity Family Day. Illinois residents receive free Museum Entry and can participate in a community art experience led by Chicago artist Shala., as well as design and test a prototype during the opening of the *Innovation Studio*.

The Innovation Studio, open through February 24, provides a creative space for guests to become innovators themselves! Powered by guests' own curiosity and inspired by our gallery spotlighting local innovators, guests will have access to a variety of materials and tools to create prototypes that solve everyday challenges using design thinking. Sessions are offered at various times throughout the day, and school and community groups may call (773) 684-1414 to reserve a workshop. *Included with Museum Entry*.

The Black Creativity Gala January 26

The Black Creativity Gala, planned in collaboration with a committee of prominent African-American leaders, raises money to support the annual Black Creativity program at MSI. This black-tie event is a celebration of art and innovation, providing guests with late-night access to the Museum's world-renowned exhibits as well as exclusive experiences. *Additional ticket purchase required*.
