MUSEUM OF SCIENCE AND INDUSTRY EXPANDS ACCESS TO FAB LAB PROGRAMS TO REACH MORE CHICAGO YOUTH AND MUSEUM VISITORS

CHICAGO (June 12, 2015) — The Museum of Science and Industry, Chicago (MSI) is expanding programs in its Wanger Family Fab Lab so more Chicago students and Museum guests can explore 3D printing and other cutting-edge technology to create innovative projects.

The announcement coincides with President Obama's call to action to create a "nation of makers" and was part of a White House event kicking off the National Week of Making, June 12 – 18, 2015.

MSI's Fab Lab is a state-of-the-art digital fabrication laboratory featuring high-tech software and equipment. Museum guests can design and make items from practical to whimsical, while Chicago students in after-school programs develop projects and learn skills like critical thinking, creativity and teamwork.

The expanded programming announced today includes:

- Doubling the capacity of 3D printing workshops for Museum guests this summer and adding new workshops on electronics, wearable technologies and 3D design this fall.
 MSI expects 12,000 guests will participate in these workshops this year.
- Increasing the number of after-school Innovation Clubs this fall so that more Chicago youth from high-needs neighborhoods gain digital design and engineering skills and exposure to STEM careers.
- Supporting schools in creating their own fabrication labs by launching an equipment loan program so they can try out DIY technologies before they buy their own.

"MSI opened its Fab Lab in 2007. Since then, our programs have aimed to inspire students and introduce them to the possibilities that exist in innovation, engineering, design and other STEM fields," said David Mosena, the Museum's president and CEO. "You are learning that they can create designs, build items and solve problems – skills that will help them throughout their future."
